

Day 1 | Drive to Fayoum.

Meals Included: Breakfast, Lunch box

Meet your guide at the lobby, leave the hotel and drive to Fayoum to start your tour with (Approx. 02-hour drive), we will visit **El Lahun pyramid** Like the other Twelfth Dynasty pyramids in the Faiyum, the Pyramid of Lahun is made of mud brick, but here the core of the pyramid consists of a network of stone and then proceed to the **Pyramid Maidum** is an archaeological site in Upper Egypt. It contains a large pyramid and several mud-brick mastabas. The pyramid was Egypt's first straight-sided one, but it partially collapsed in ancient times. The area is located around 62 miles south of modern Cairo.

Finishing the day by the **Hawara Pyramid**, Hawara is an archaeological site of Ancient Egypt, south of the site of Crocodilopolis at the entrance to the depression of the Fayyum oasis. It is the site of a pyramid built by the Pharaoh Amenemhat III in the 19th century BC.

Day 2 | Qasr el Sagha / Madinet Madi / Karanis

meet your guide at the lobby to start your visit by **Qasr el sagha**, the date of the temple is a source of debate among scholars, but its plan suggests that the structure was built no later than the Middle Kingdom. It's architecture, however, was interpreted by early explorers as being in the style of Old Kingdom structures. The temple was constructed of limestone blocks of different sizes, which fit tightly together without the use of mortar and with oblique corner joints.

Then we proceed to **Madinet Madi**, Madinet Madi Archaeological site is located in a small hill of a strategic position guarding the southwestern entrance to the Fayoum about 35 km far from Medinet El-Fayoum. The town was called Dj3 in Hieroglyphs, while during the Greek period it was identified as Narmouthis (Bresciani, 1980). The name Madi, which means "City of the Past", seems to have originated from the Arab existence. A document, dates back to the ninth century AD., has been found in the site mentioning Madi as the name of the site.

Free time for Lunch

Finishing our day by visiting **Karanis**, founded in the first half of the 3rd century BC; at that time, the new rulers of Egypt after Alexander the Great, the Ptolemies, developed the Fayurn into a large fertile zone. The lake, once covering nearly the whole oasis, shrank to the level on which we see it today, its shores lying at – 45 m below sea level

Ptolemy I (ruled from 305 to 283 BC) and Ptolemy ii ruled from 285 to 246 BC) needed Greek speaking settlers as administrators and soldiers for their new



government; tens of thousands of people flocked into the country on the Nile at that time, arriving from all parts of the Greek-speaking world around the Mediterranean. The first Ptolemais showed themselves as very civilized and wise rulers by not seizing land from the indigenous population but by creating new land in the Fayum and in the Delta with their advanced technological knowledge
